

## **SASS Shooting Category Changes**

The recent SASS Convention resulted in some changes to the shooting categories officially recognized by SASS. The newest edition of the Shooters Handbook covers them in detail, but here's what you need to know in a nutshell, and how the RMR is handling the changes.

1. Modern category---It's gone. Now adjustable sight revolvers may be used in any age-based category.
2. Traditional category--- It's gone. Taking the place of Traditional and Modern are new age-based categories.
3. New age-based categories: Cowboy/Cowgirl (any age, two-handed shooting permitted including adjustable sight revolvers); and Wrangler/Lady Wrangler (age 36 and older, same style).
4. That makes for the following age-based categories, understanding that you can always shoot in a "younger" category if you wish (except, of course, Junior); Junior (up to age 16, potentially split into Buckaroo as well); Cowboy (any age); Wrangler (36 or older); 49'er (49 and older); Senior (60 and older); Silver Senior (65 and older); and Elder Statesman (70 and older), plus lady counterparts to each.

Beginning with Next month's match at the Rattlesnake Mountain Rangers, we will be using these categories. So if you shot Modern or Traditional, please figure out which category you want now and let us know on your score sheet!
